

Report re. Participation in the American Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology Course in Atlanta, October 23-26 2024

I had the great pleasure of attending the above-mentioned course. The course provided an excellent overview of the HPV natural history and carcinogenesis, diagnostics and treatment of squamous and glandular lesions, how to manage pregnant and immunosuppressed women with HPV and CIN, and recommendations on HPV vaccination. In particular, I found the work-shops very useful. We went through numerous cases, aiming at image recognition. It was fruitful to engage in discussions on colposcopic impression and clinical management.
