

## **Report for NFOG from the RCOG course “Management of the Labour Ward” in London, 4.th -7.th of June 2024**

I was very much delighted by the opportunity to attend in the obstetric course “Management of the Labour Ward”. At first, I had planned my attendance for the course in 2023, but as the course was mostly online, I decided to wait for the 2024 course in June.

In 2024, again the course was online for the first 3 days and the 4.th day was with a physical appearance in London. So I signed up for the course together with some good colleagues from other hospitals.

We, four Danish obstetricians, attended the online course together. The online course covered lots of obstetric topics – from medical conditions to labour ward pathology, and also topics of more ethnological character. The general impression from this was that in Denmark we are quite updated on the majority of topics.

Especially the last day with physical attendance in London was interesting, as it covered the daily lead and teamwork of the labour ward, and how to optimize the general labour ward set-up and collaboration processes. Several points from this last day were valuable for me to bring home. Moreover, it is always interesting to discuss clinical practice with colleagues from other countries – to exchange perspectives of practice and experiences.
