

Clinical visit to Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen

Dear NFOG Board,

My visit to Clinic for pregnancy and fetal medicine, University Hospital of Copenhagen, Denmark, was possible with financial help from the NFOG fund. It took place from the 28th to the 29th of October 2024.

The clinic is a Nordic Network of Fetal Medicine referral hospital. The Danish colleagues warmly welcomed me, and I was allowed to follow their work for two days. I observed highly specialised prenatal ultrasound scans of suspected fetal anomalies as well as morfological examinations. In addition, I attended the morning meetings with relevant case reports. The first day, I also observed invasive procedures including CVS and intruterine blood transfusion. There were no laser treatments during these two days.

It has been valuable for me to follow the patient evaluations, to meet Danish colleagues and to see the facilities in the department to which I refer patients from time to time.
